Lamar Open House: Curriculum Continued

Reading: Students are expected to read independently for a sustained period of time. Students are expected to be at a level I by the end of first grade. We will assess and update parents on students' reading levels frequently. Students are also expected to learn 100 first grade sight words in addition to mastering the 75 kindergarten words.

Writing: Students are expected to write their first and last names and write 3-5 complete sentences with proper capitalization and punctuation. Spelling in developmental and phonetic (inventive) spelling is encouraged. We will send home spelling lists as part of our phonics program.



Lamar Open House: Curriculum Continued

Math: Students are expected to know how to order, compare, write, read, and understand place value for numbers up to 120. They are required to compose and decompose (add and subtract) numbers up to 20. They need to skip count by 2's, 5's, and 10's. They will tell time to the nearest hour and half-hour and identify coins and their values. This is not an exhaustive list, just the highlights.

Science: Integrated units that include Matter & Energy, Force & Motion, Earth & Space, and Organisms & Environments.

Social Studies: Integrated units include Geography & Culture, History, Government & Citizenship, and Economics, Science & Technology.
